

PURPOSE:

To identify the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority's (GMHA's):

- “licensed” acute care and skilled nursing care bed capacities;
- “urgent care” bed capacities;
- “certified airborne infection isolation” room capacities; and
- “negative pressure” bed capacities (to include both licensed and unlicensed beds).

POLICY:

A. GMHA has the following “licensed bed capacities” with respect to acute care, skilled nursing care:

B. GMHA has a total of 5 patient care room capacities with respect to the Urgent Care Unit.

C. GMHA has the following capabilities and capacities with respect to “certified airborne infection isolation” rooms and “negative pressure” bed capacities:

- Certified Airborne Infection Isolation Rooms: Total: 18
 - ❖ The Guam Memorial Hospital (GMH) has fourteen (14) Certified Airborne Infection Isolation Rooms.
 - ❖ The Skilled Nursing Unit (SNU) has four (4) Certified Airborne Infection Isolation Rooms.

Note: Regarding airborne infection isolation, please refer to specific policies and procedures that comprise GMHA's Infection Control Manual.

- Negative Pressure Bed Capacity: Total: 47
 - ❖ The Guam Memorial Hospital (GMH) has the capability to create “negative pressure” environments in its Emergency Department (ED), ED Annex, Urgent Care Unit, Telemetry Unit, Pediatrics Unit, Operating Room and L & D Unit; and this capability gives GMH a “negative pressure” bed capacity of approximately forty-seven (47).

- D. A more detailed table is provided that breaks down the above data into bed/station types and/or Department/Unit (*see Attachment I*).
- E. Although the beds/stations in use may fluctuate as a result of GMHA staffing and/or the Community's demand for Hospital and SNU services, the maximum licensed/certified bed/station capacities shall remain constant until changed by planned, approved capital expansion.
- F. This bed capacity information shall be useful for your management, reporting, budgeting and planning purposes.
