

**NOTICE OF FILING OF APPLICATION UNDER THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF LABOR'S  
PERMANENT LABOR CERTIFICATION PROGRAM**

An application concerning the employment of alien workers for the following permanent position will be filed with the U.S. Department of Labor. This Notice of Filing will be posted for ten (10) consecutive business days, ending between thirty (30) and one hundred eighty (180) days before filing the permanent labor certification application.

**Position Title:** Hospital Staff Pathologist/Laboratory Medical Director (1 Vacancy)

**Minimum Requirements:** Doctor of Medicine degree (may be foreign equivalent), completion of three (3) year residency program in anatomic and clinical pathology, Board Eligible or Board Certified in Anatomic & Clinical Pathology, and be eligible for Guam medical licensure upon hiring.

**Position Duties:** Diagnoses diseases by pathological examination of body tissues, body fluids, blood, urine, and bone marrow and performs necropsies. Identifies the etiology, pathogenesis, morphological change, and clinical significance of diseases. Prepares tissues for microscopic examination. Diagnoses nature and source of pathological conditions causing illness or death. Prepares comprehensive interpretive pathology reports. Performs procedures such as biopsies and fine needle aspirations (FNAs) of superficial nodules, and prepares report of findings and recommends treatment and/or additional diagnostic testing. Performs anatomical pathology examinations such as biopsies and necropsies, and clinical pathological procedures related to hematology, bacteriology, serology, biochemistry, and parasitology. Manages, clinical laboratory services, oversees blood bank to ensure that blood products are correctly managed and safe for administration, and formulates plans and procedures. Attends department meetings and participates in and supports appropriate to the College of American Pathologist (CAP) and Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendment (CLIA) with Centers of Medicare/Medicaid Services (CMS) related activities to ensure regulatory compliance are met.

**Rate of Pay:** \$245,000.00 per annum
